What Skills & Attributes are we looking for in an u11?

Batting

- Comfortable and balanced set up
- Understanding of Step and Swing
- Decision making recognising balls that can be attacked and which need to be defended

Bowling

- Bowl with a safe and repeatable action
- Focus on Balance, Alignment & Momentum to the target
- Consistent Run up
- Exploration of pace and spin

Fielding

- Catch and throw the ball in a strong and balanced position
- Ability to throw the ball safely

Wicket Keeping

- Ability to catch the ball in a balanced position with a strong stable base
- Maintain a still head when catching the ball
- Maintain a strong catching area with hands
