Eligibility for the Berkshire Pathway

Video submissions are for the U14 - U18 age groups (Year 9 to Year 13)

To be eligible for the Berkshire Cricket Pathway you need to meet one of the following criteria:

- Go to a school within Berkshire
- Live in Berkshire
- Play for a Berkshire club (in the 2026 season)

If you do not meet any of the above criteria, the only other route is by referral directly by the Head of Talent Pathway at a First Class County.

Players can apply directly, you do not need to go through a club or school coach.

(No batters, fixed camera position)

2 of the balls from behind the net looking at the bowlers face

(No batters, fixed camera position)

2 of the balls from side on view

- Include run up and follow through in the view

(No batters, fixed camera position)



Batting

8 Balls in total

From competent bowlers, Camera fixed where the umpire would stand behind the non strikers stumps facing the batter

4 of the balls against Spin Bowlers

4 of the balls against Seam Bowlers

Demonstrate a variety of front and back foot shots



Spin Bowling

6 Balls in total

No Batters in the video so we can see the ball bounce

4 of the balls from behind showing run up and delivery

- Include any variations you have
(No batters, fixed camera position)

2 of the balls from side on view

- Include run up and follow through in the view
(No batters, fixed camera position)



Wicket-Keeping



6 Balls in total of the wicket keeper standing up to the stumps

No Batters in the video

4 of the balls from a front on view

- 2 of these off side takes
- 2 of these leg side takes

(Wicket Keeper in full frame, fixed camera)

2 of the balls from side on view

- 1 of these is an off side take
- 1 of these is a leg side take



What happens next?

Unsuccessful players will be provided with feedback on request. This will help them understand how to bridge the gap to selection. Players may also be signposted to the MCCF Hub programme.

Successful players will be invited to 1 or 2 training sessions where our coaches can work with them closely. From this stage, the players will either be selected to be part of our Winter Training programme or given individual feedback on areas for development.
